Our Goal

Our Goal is to provide a Christ-honoring, fun-loving, family-based, activity filled week to all campers while providing the saving message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ through worship times with songs, games, skits and lots of hands on activities. Campers will be given lots of time and opportunity to play, learn and grow both physically and spiritually.

Camp Themes

Every day, our kids are bombarded with questions: Did God really create everything? Why do bad things happen? Was Noah's ark real? Why do I need to be saved? Can I trust the Bible? At this VBS, your kids will explore the biblical answers to these questions as they set off on an epic adventure from Genesis to Revelation.

Camp Information

Location - The Day Camp for this year will be held at the New Life Christian Church located at 480 Huntingwood Drive, Toronto, Ontario, M1W 1G4.

Hours- The Day Camp operates from Monday July 8 to Friday July 12, 2024 from 9:30 am to 3:30 pm sharp. All parents/guardian are required to ensure that children are dropped-off from 9:30AM onwards and picked-up at 4:00PM at the latest. For after hours care and arrangements please contact Tavit Garabedian

Ages-The Day Camp will be offered to kids between the ages of 4 to 13 years of age. Space is limited and priority will be given to campers who register first.

Required Material- The cost for each week includes materials, equipment, two snacks a day, 1 hot lunch, and take home crafts. Day campers must bring a hat and a reusable water bottle with their name marked.

Prohibited Materials-The use of iPod's, mp3 players and electronic devices is prohibited during camp hours and may be confiscated from the camper for the day.

Supervision- Campers are supervised at all times. Counselors have educational backgrounds, extensive experience working with children, and are assisted by responsible and enthusiastic volunteers. We will have a registered Nurse present during the camp, and several of our staff members are trained in First Aid.

Special Needs- Please note any special needs on the registration form if applicable. We are unable to provide one-on-one supervision, specific medical support or a nut-free environment.

Cost- Regular price for camp is \$150 for the week. We accept cheques or cash. Make cheque payable to: Armenian Evangelical Brotherhood Church of Toronto.

Day Camp Policies

1. The Vacation Bible School Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper who is a hazard to the health and safety of others, or who appears to have rejected the reasonable controls of the camp.
2. Every precaution is taken for the safety and good health of the campers, but in the event of an accident or sickness, **The Armenian Evangelical Brotherhood Church** including the Board, Staff and Volunteers are hereby released from any liability.
3. In the event that a camper requires special medication, X-ray or treatment beyond that which is possible at camp, the parents will be notified immediately and will be charged with the additional expense of transportation and special care.
4. No refund will be made for dismissal due to disciplinary action.
5. All campers or their parent/guardian must assume liability for any damage to camp property.

Child Escorts

If you have made arrangements for an alternate person to pick-up your child, please inform the day camp staff ahead of time. Your child needs to be signed-in and signed-out every day. This means that every child needs to be picked up by a parent or guardian at all times and cannot leave the premises without further notification to the camp director.

Medical Release

If at any time due to circumstances such as an accident, sudden illness or emergency, I give my consent for any required medical treatment including all medical and surgical treatment, X-ray, laboratory, anesthesia, and other medical and/or hospital procedures as may be performed or prescribed by the attending physician and/or paramedics for my child and waive my right to informed consent of treatment. This waiver applies only in the event that neither parent/guardian can be reached in the case of an emergency.

Pictures

Every day of the week, we try to preserve the memory of camp by taking pictures and video of the children. I allow pictures to be taken during the camp.
